

Please join us for the launch of Making Waves – an independent podcast seeking to amplify lesser heard perspectives on water

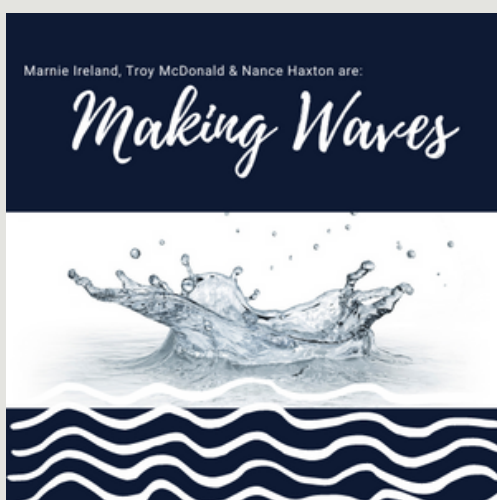
